













Less reliant on aid, improving FDI








Garment is pillar of the exports

Bicycle "made in Cambodia"




A Success Story

- 1.5 million bicycles exported between Jan-Sep;
- 360,000 bikes were sold to Germany
- Increasing demand in the US and worldwide
- Bicycle export market did not decline during the COVID-19 pandemic
- Cambodia is more competitive than other countries in SEA
- China+1 sourcing strategy



Towards industrial diversification



Trade agreements or preferential schemes with importing countries

- EU with "Everything But Arms" scheme (Partial withdrawal affects 20% of the exported products)
- The ASEAN-China Free Trade Area (ACFTA).
- Canada's Market Access Initiative for Least Developed Countries
- The ASEAN-Japan Comprehensive Economic Partnership (AJCEP)
- The US with the Generalized System of Preference (GSP) status.
- FTA with China
- FTA negotiation with South-Korea
