







Institutional Framework





- The City Corporations and Paurashavas (municipalities) are responsible for establishing, operating, and maintaining the Sanitation, Wastewater, Faecal Sludge Management, and Solid Waste Management services.
- Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) and Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) provide technical and financial assistance to these sectors through various development projects.




