

GSBF Connect: Manufacturing and Innovation in Southeast Asia

Southeast Asia has remained a bright spot with ASEAN; poised for a 4.5 per cent real GDP growth in 2021 (Source: IMF). ASEAN's growth is expected to accelerate with the implementation of the **Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP)**, which will create the world's largest trading bloc comprising about 30 per cent of global GDP and about a third of the world's population.
